 - a. ONCA 20-45, An Act to amend ONCA 14-39 to revise the definition of benefits to disallow elected officials from receiving cash payments when they elect to decline health insurance coverage; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
 - b. ONCA 20-46, An Act to establish a plan in Osage law for replenishing the Osage Nation Permanent Fund by Fiscal Year 2026; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
 - c. ONCA 20-47, An Act to authorize and appropriate one hundred eighty thousand dollars (\$180,000) to the Osage Nation Foundation to be administered and distributed as donations and arts matching grants; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
 - d. ONCA 20-48, An Act to authorize and appropriate five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to the Burial Assistance Fund; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
 - e. ONCA 20-49, An Act to authorize and appropriate twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to the Court Appointed Special Advocates of Osage and Pawnee Counties as a grant to benefit members of the Osage Nation and the community; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
 - f. ONCA 20-50, An Act to authorize and appropriate five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to the Executive Branch for legal fees related to the gaming compact litigation; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
 - g. ONCA 20-51, An Act to establish minimum standards to benefit Osage Nation employees in the work environment; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)

- h. ONCA 20-52, An Act to authorize and appropriate six hundred twenty six thousand one hundred eighty dollars (\$626,180) to Head Start and the Matching Grant Fund for Head Start; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
- i. ONCA 20-53, An Act to authorize and appropriate four million three hundred thousand dollars (\$4,300,000) to the Osage Nation Member Health Benefit Fund for Osage members sixty-five (65) years of age and over; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
- j. ONCA 20-54, An Act to authorize and appropriate eight million seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$8,750,000) to the Osage Nation Health Benefit Fund for Osage members under sixty-five (65) years of age as set forth in the Osage Nation Health Benefit Act, 16 ONC § 3-101 *et seq*; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
- k. ONCA 20-55, An Act to authorize and appropriate twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to the Regional Gathering Fund; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
- l. ONCA 20-56, An Act to require all political contributions made on behalf of the Osage Nation to be funded, administered and awarded by the Political Contributions Committee. (Potts)
- m. ONCA 20-57, An Act to authorize and appropriate eight million dollars (\$8,000,000) to the Higher Education Scholarship Fund; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
- n. ONCA 20-64, An Act to amend Chapter 2 of Title 6 of the Criminal Code on Crimes Against Persons; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Stabler)
- o. ONCA 20-65, An Act to authorize and appropriate one million seven hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$1,720,000) to the Capital Asset Fund for Wakon Iron Chapel in the Pawhuska Indian Village; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Stabler)
- p. ONCA 20-66, An Act to amend the Osage Nation Higher Education Fund Act definition of student in good standing; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Revard)
- q. ONCA 20-67, An Act to amend the Osage Nation Gaming Reform Act of 2007, 14 ONC § 12-105(C) 1 to make the Annual Plan of Operation due on or about August 15 of each year; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
- r. ONCA 20-68, An Act to amend the Economic Development Fund at 10 ONC § 1-102, to authorize small business loans out of the Fund to Osage owned businesses; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
- s. ONCA 20-69, An Act to appropriate two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to the Economic Development Fund for small business loans; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
- t. ONCA 20-70, An Act to establish a compensation commission to recommend adjustments to the compensation of elected officials for the Osage Nation Congress; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)

- u. ONCA 20-71, An Act to repeal 15 ONC § 1A-112 that allows expenditure of nontribal revenue without appropriation; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
- v. ONCR 20-20, A Resolution to request the implementation of a recycling program for all Osage Nation facilities, or to have a recycling program explored and findings reported. (Potts)
- w. ONCR 20-25, A Resolution Declaring Congressional consent and approval of the Osage Nation Gaming Enterprise Board's Annual Plan of Operation for fiscal year 2021. (Goodfox)
- x. ONCR 20-26, A Resolution to establish a commission to study and report its findings on the issue of districting for the election of representatives. (Potts)
