General Order Day 1 - Legislation is read in by the Sponsor
 - a. ONCA 14-86, An Act to authorize and appropriate one million five hundred (\$1,500,000) to the Health Benefit Plan Fund; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Edwards)
 - b. ONCA 15-23, An Act to amend and restate the law governing special session of the Osage Nation Congress, 15 ONC § 1-102 through § 1-105 to define national emergency; to require legislation to be filed and listed by number on the proclamation; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Whitehorn)

- c. ONCA 15-35, n Act to provide an appropriation in the amount of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to Tribal Development and Land Acquisition for project costs to build the Hominy Wellness Center; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Supernaw)
- d. ONCA 15-36, An Act to amend ONCA 14-70 to reduce the appropriation to the Division of Child, Family, and Senior Community Services for fiscal year 2015 by the amount of five million four hundred forty seven thousand five hundred fifty five dollars (\$5,447,555); and to change the Division composition.(Pratt)

General Order Day 2 – Amendments may be proposed

- a. ONCA 14-58, An Act to authorize the Osage Nation to invest in real property in the original Osage Reservation Area offered for purchase; to create a real property purchase fund; to authorize and appropriate the sum of one dollar (\$1) to the real property purchase fund; to declare an emergency and establish an alternate effective date. (Supernaw)
- b. ONCA 15-39, An Act to amend ONCA 14-72 to provide a supplemental appropriation to the Division of Education and Early Childhood Services for fiscal year 2015 in the amount of two hundred ninety two thousand six hundred ninety one dollars (\$292,691). (Walker)
