BASKETBALL CAMP

JUNE 1 - JUNE 3

Learn fundamental and advanced skills of basketball from a staff of experienced basketball coaches and assistants. Participants will be divided by age groups and skill levels. They will receive individual and group instruction and coaching. Participants are asked to wear shorts, t-shirt or other appropriate jersey/shirt, and sneakers. Camp size is limited. PHOTOGRAPHY CAMP

Participants will learn the basics of how to use their digital camera to take good photos. Younger students will create collages from photos printed during class, while the older students will learn how to edit them and print out a favorite photo each day. At the end of camp, a hardcover book will be created from the students' photos and given to all students. Each student will select one photo to be featured along with a short bio of that student. Books will be mailed to students approximately two weeks after the completion of the camp. This beginner's class is for anyone with a point-and-shoot camera or digital SLR. Participants must bring their own digital cameras but basic point-and-shoot cameras are fine. Camp size is limited. Registrations accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
