 - a. ONCA 16-60, An Act to amend the Osage Nation Membership Act at 21 ONC § 1-302; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Walker)

ONCA 16-63, An Act to amend ONCA 15-84 to provide a supplemental appropriation of nine hundred thirty three thousand one hundred thirty five dollars (\$933,135) in federal funds, fifty seven thousand dollars (\$57,000) in tribal funds and seventeen thousand four hundred ninety seven dollars (\$17,497) in other funds to the Division of Governmental Operations for fiscal year 2016 in the amount of one million seven thousand six hundred thirty two dollars (\$1,007,632); and to establish an alternate effective date. ONCA 16-37, An Act to amend 16 ONC § 3-104 of the Health Benefit Act remove certain requirements; to change the minimum benefit to Members age sixty five (65) or over to one thousand dollars (\$1,000); to set the benefit for elders calculating the maximum benefit to participants under sixty five (65) years of age; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Edwards)
- b. ONCA 16-64, An Act to amend the ONCA 15-86 to provide a supplemental appropriation to the Cultural Preservation, Arts, Heritage and Language Division of the Osage Nation for fiscal year 2016 in the amount of one hundred eighty four thousand five hundred thirty eight dollars (\$184,538); and to establish an alternate effective date. (Walker)
