 - a. ONCA 20-73, An Act to provide an appropriation to the Minerals Council for fiscal year 2021 in the amount of one million sixteen thousand five hundred forty seven dollars (\$1,016,547); and to establish an alternate effective date. (Revard)
 - b. ONCA 20-83, an Act to amend the Osage Nation Health Benefit Act at 16 ONC § 3-106 to prohibit the accrual of unused health benefits; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Stabler)
8. General Order Day 2 – Amendments May Be Proposed
 - a. ONCA 20-45, An Act to amend ONCA 14-39 to revise the definition of benefits to disallow elected officials from receiving cash payments when they elect to decline health insurance coverage; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
 - b. ONCA 20-49, An Act to authorize and appropriate twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to the Court Appointed Special Advocates of Osage and Pawnee Counties as a grant to benefit members of the Osage Nation and the community; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
 - c. ONCA 20-68, An act to amend the Economic Development Fund at 10 ONC § 1-102, to authorize small business loans out of the Fund to Osage owned businesses; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)

- d. ONCA 20-69, An Act to appropriate two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to the Economic Development Fund for small business loans; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
- e. ONCA 20-71, An Act to repeal 15 ONC § 1A-112 that allows expenditure of nontribal revenue with out appropriation; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Potts)
- f. ONCA 20-76, An Act to provide an appropriation to the Executive Branch of the Osage Nation for Fiscal Year 2021 in the amount of forty five million six hundred seventy two thousand six hundred ninety dollars (\$45,672,690) and five million dollars (\$5,000,000) in restricted revenue reserved to the Wah Zha Zhi Health Center; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Revard)
- g. ONCA 20-82, An Act to authorize the IDC Departments and Tribal Works to expend monies appropriated through the FY 2021 appropriation bills; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Walker)
