General Order Day 1 – Legislation is Read in by the Sponsor

- a. ONCA 15-90, An Act to amend ONCA 12-107 to require unexpended monies appropriated for specific capital projects to revert back to the Treasury and to add reporting requirements; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Shaw)
- b. ONCR 15-24, A Resolution commending Herman “Mogri” Lookout for his leadership, dedication and service to the Osage People and the Osage Nation in preserving and passing on our language; and directing distribution. (Pratt)
