 - a. ONCA 15-78, An Act to provide an appropriation to the Office of the Attorney General of the Osage Nation for fiscal year 2016 in the amount of nine hundred forty four thousand six hundred sixteen dollars (\$944,616); and to establish an alternate effective date. (Jech)
 - b. ONCA 15-79, An Act to provide an appropriation to the Office of the Principal Chief of the Osage Nation for fiscal year 2016 in the amount of one million eight hundred thirteen thousand thirty three dollars (\$1,813,033); and to establish an alternate effective date. (Jech)

- c. ONCA 15-81, An Act to provide an appropriation to the Judicial Branch of the Osage Nation for fiscal year 2016 in the amount of three hundred ninety one thousand six hundred five dollars (\$391,605); and to establish an alternate effective date. (Jech)
- d. ONCA 15-82, An Act to provide an appropriation to the Land, Commerce and Public Safety Division of the Osage Nation for fiscal year 2016 in the amount of ten million nine hundred twenty four thousand three hundred two dollars (\$10,924,302); and to establish an alternate effective date. (Jech)
- e. ONCA 15-83, An Act to provide an appropriation to the Health, Fitness and Wellness Division of the Osage Nation for fiscal year 2016 in the amount of fifteen million four hundred ninety five thousand nine hundred fifty nine dollars (\$15,495,959); and to establish an alternate effective date. (Jech)
- f. ONCA 15-85, An Act to provide an appropriation to the Education and Early Childhood Services Division of the Osage Nation for fiscal year 2016 in the amount of eight million three hundred seventy one thousand five hundred ninety seven dollars (\$8,371,597); and to establish an alternate effective date. (Jech)
- g. ONCA 15-87, An Act to provide an appropriation to the Child, Family and Senior Community Services Division of the Osage Nation for fiscal year 2016 in the amount of three million four hundred forty six thousand one hundred one dollars (\$3,446,101); and to establish an alternate effective date. (Jech)
- h. ONCA 15-94, An Act to amend and restate the Business, Commission and Advisory Boards Act, 15 ONC § 5-101 et seq. creating a new board category for the Health Authority Board; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Shaw)
- i. ONCA 15-97, An Act to require the Osage Nation to utilize drug testing protocols to ensure the proper collection and interpretation of test results for the results for the benefit of employees; and to establish an alternate effective date. (Shaw)
- j. ONCR 15-20, A Resolution to authorize and approve execution of a "Contract for Treatment Services or Other Integrated Services-Fixed Rate FY16" with the State of Oklahoma-Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services; and to authorize a limited waiver of sovereign immunity from suit and a consent to jurisdiction.
